In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1798; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

George Hannahs

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Saginaw Mich. and is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Sew Fairy Queen* of Saginaw whereof *Columus Shaw* is at present Master; and as he has sworn *he* is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Conneaut* last State of *Ohio* in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her Enrollment at the Port of *Cleveland* dated February 14. 1863 and numbered '9' now surrendered having changed Owners & Dist. while from home port

And said Enrollment having certified that the said *Sew* or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *75*<sup>*50*</sup>/<sub>*100*</sub> feet *—* inches her breadth is *18*<sup>*72*</sup>/<sub>*100*</sub> feet *—* inches her depth is *5*<sup>*16*</sup>/<sub>*100*</sub> feet *—* inches and that she measures *Sixty four* tons *81* ninety-fifths that she is a *Scow* has a *Square* stern and a *Scow* head.

And the said *George Hannahs* agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Sew* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this *13.* day of *April* in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-*four*.
