In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "~~An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam,~~" passed 7th July, 1838, and "~~the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same;~~ also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Sackett Harbor State of New York in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Rochester N.Y. dated April 8th 1858 and numbered now surrendered License showing expired while from home port

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Barque or vessel has one deck and three mast and that her length is 132 feet 6 inches her breadth 25 feet 6 inches her depth 11 feet inches and that she measures Three hundred forty four tons fifty seven ninety-fifths that she is a Barque has a square stern head.

And the said Thomas Bundy agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schomer has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
