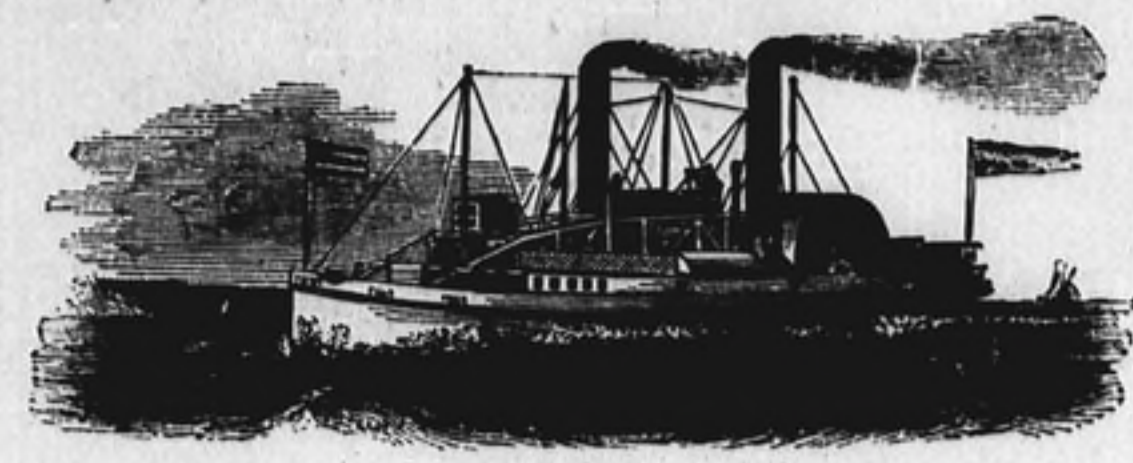

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

Henry C. Winslow Att<sup>y</sup>

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that Nathan C. Winslow and H. J. Winslow who both reside at New York City are

each one half part Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner Tracy J. Bronson of Buffalo whereof Wilson Vance is at present Master; and as he has sworn he

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1857 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Cleveland dated August 28. 1857 and numbered "85" now surrendered having changed Owners and District

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 137 <sup>58</sup>/<sub>100</sub> feet inches her breadth 26 feet inches her depth 11 <sup>42</sup>/<sub>100</sub> feet inches and that she measures Three Hundred and eighty one tons twenty three ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and plain head.

And the said Henry C. Winslow having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this 21. day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four.
