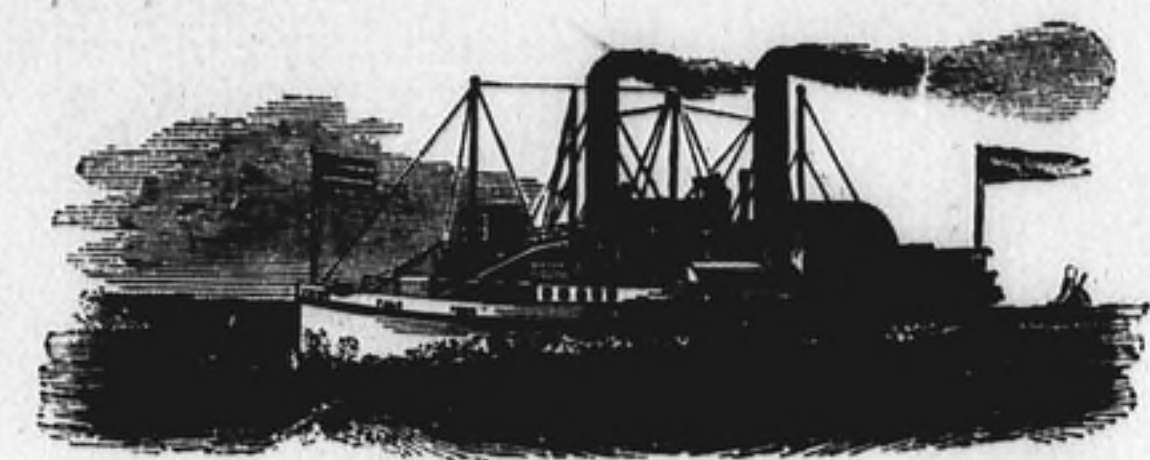

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

her is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Chicago dated February 26. 1862 and numbered "5" now surrendered, License having expired while from home port

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 143 feet 5 inches her breadth 30 feet 4 inches her depth 11 feet 11 1/2 inches and that she measures Four Hundred and seventy eight tons sixteen ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern head.

And the said T. S. McKenzie and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
