In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

is at present Master; and as he has sworn he is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port dated March 18. 1859 and numbered "1" now surrendered having changed Owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has one deck and one mast and that her length is 185 feet 6 inches her breadth 27 feet 2 inches her depth 12 feet 2 inches and that she measures Five Hundred and eighty eight tons sixty five ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a stern head and a plain head.

And the said Tho^s D. Dole agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
