In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that H. C. Winslow and H. J. Winslow who reside at New York City and J. M. Smith and B. S. Wolvin who reside at Cleveland Ohio are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Barque American Union of Buffalo whereof B. S. Wolvin is at present Master; and as he has sworn he

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1862 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Cleveland dated July 29, 1862, and numbered 69, now surrendered, having changed Owners and Districts

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Barque or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 186 ⁴⁸/₁₀₀ feet inches her breadth 33 ¹⁶/₁₀₀ feet inches her depth 13 ¹⁴/₁₀₀ feet inches and that she measures Seven Hundred & sixty four tons four ninety-fifths that she is a Barque has a square stern and figure head.

And the said Henry C. Winslow agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
