In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N.Y. and that he is the Secretary of The Western Transportation Company, a corporation organized under the Laws of the State of New York, located at Tonawanda in the District of Buffalo Creek, and that said Company is the true

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller Racine of Buffalo
whereof Wm. H. Arthur

is at present Master; and as he has sworn he is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland
State of Ohio in the year 1856, as appears by the Certificate of her last
Enrollment at this Port dated August 23, 1860 and numbered
108, now surrendered having changed Owners.

And said Enrollment having certified that
the said Propeller or vessel has one deck and one mast and that
her length is 193 ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ feet inches
her breadth 30 ³¹/₁₀₀ feet inches
her depth 12 ⁷²/₁₀₀ feet inches
and that she measures Seven Hundred & fifteen tons 18 ninety-fifths
that she is a Propeller has a square stern
and a plain head.

And the said Bird A. Root having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of
the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
