In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1859.

her length is 95 feet 7 inches
her breadth 17 feet 9 inches
her depth 9 feet inches
and that she measures One Hundred and forty two tons seventy five ninety-fifths
that she is a Canal Boat has a round stern
and no figure head.

And the said John A. Horn
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of
the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
