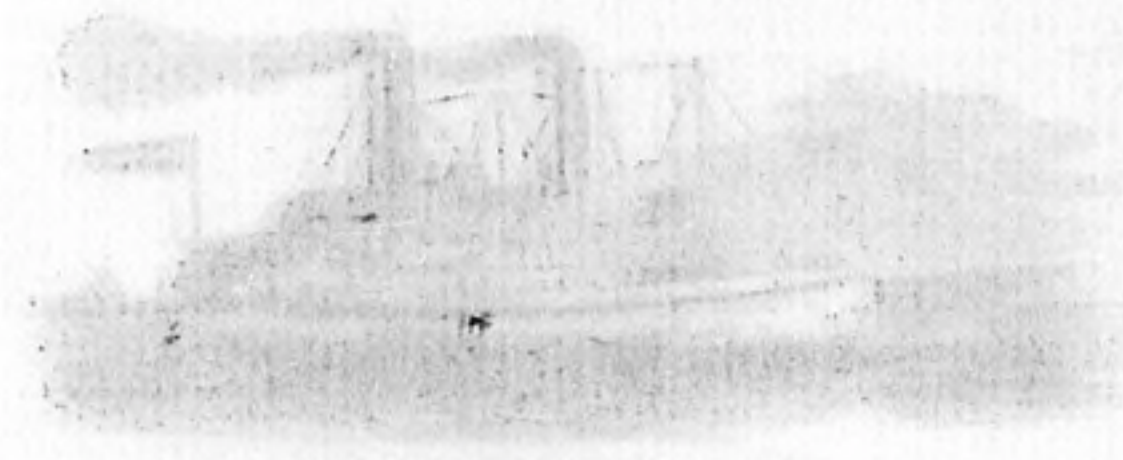

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1858, and the Act of August 8th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1856

Henry C. Winslow

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo, N.Y., and owns one half (1/2) and that he in trust for Mrs C.S. Williams, who resides at the same place, owns the remaining one half (1/2), and that they are

each one half part of the Schooner G.D. Dowsman of Buffalo Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the whereof J.D. Peterson is at present Master; and as he has sworn

he is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1857, as appears by her Temporary Register at the Port of Cleveland, dated October 6. 1862, and numbered 13, now surrendered, having changed Owners & Districts

And said Register having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 137 ⁷/₁₀₀ feet inches her breadth 25 ⁸⁸/₁₀₀ feet inches her depth 11 ¹⁵/₁₀₀ feet inches and that she measures Three Hundred & sixty nine tons 33 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and plain head.

And the said Henry C. Winslow agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this 6. day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four.
