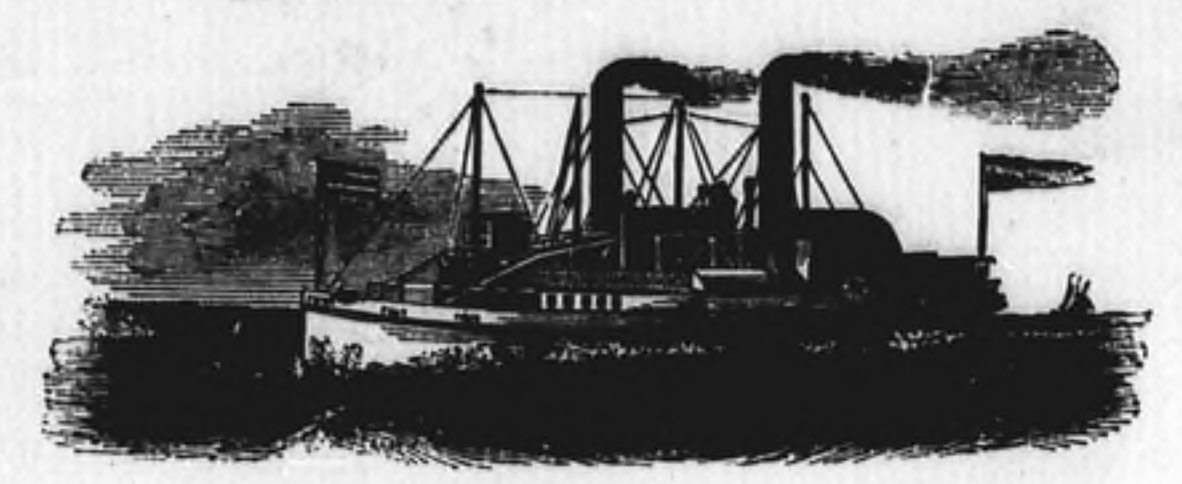

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852 amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

L O Wilcox

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Huron Ohio and owns one fourth (1/4) and that John P Wilcox resides at Huron place and owns one half (1/2) and that A W Meeker resides at the same place and owns the remaining one fourth (1/4) and that they all are*

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Barque Mariad of Huron* whereof *L O Wilcox*

is at present Master; and as he has sworn *in* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Huron* State of *Ohio* in the year *1863*, as appears by *the certificate of her former enrollment at the Port of Sandusky dated May 1863 and numbered "17" now suspended License having expired while from home port.*

And *Said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Barque* or vessel has *one* deck and *three* masts and that her length is *141* feet *2* inches her breadth *29* feet *2* inches her depth *7* feet *7* inches and that she measures *Four hundred and thirty nine* tons *thirty* ninety-fifths that she is a *Barque* has a *Square* stern and *no figure* head.

And the said *L O Wilcox* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Barque* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
