

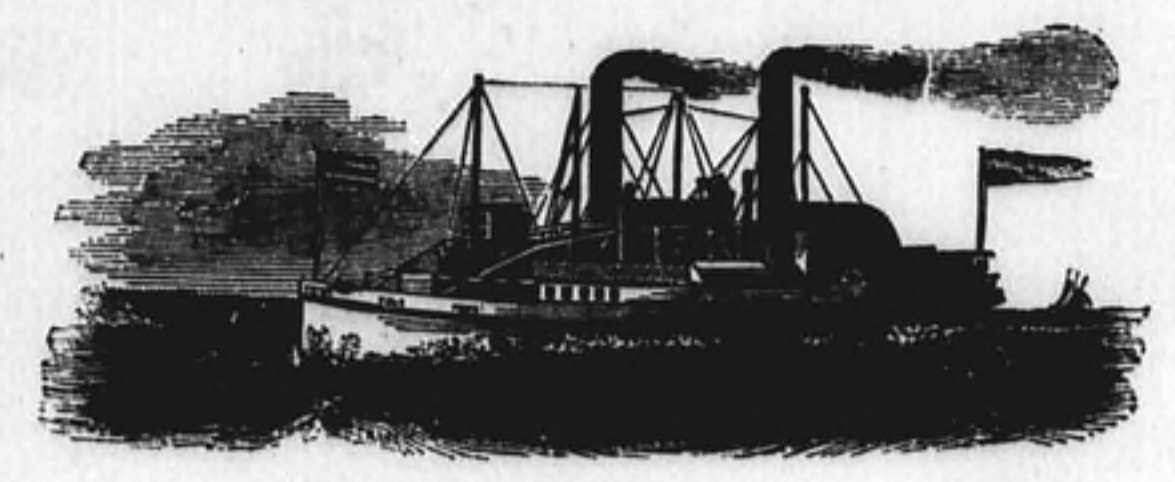

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that H. J. Winslow resides at New York City, and owns five eighths (7/8), and that A. C. Winslow resides at the same place and owns two eighths (2/8), and that J. M. Smith resides at Mentor Ohio, and owns the remaining one eighth (1/8), and that they all are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller Winslow of Buffalo whereof J. M. Smith is at present Master; and as he has sworn he

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1863 as appears by the Certificate of her former Enrollment at the Port of Cleveland, dated May 6th 1863, and numbered 56, now surrendered, having changed Owners and Districts

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has one deck and one mast and that her length is 220 ¹/₁₀₀ feet inches her breadth 32 ²⁵/₁₀₀ feet inches her depth 13 ³/₁₀₀ feet inches and that she measures Nine Hundred & nineteen tons sixty six ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a round stern and plain head.

And the said Henry C. Winslow agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
