In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

William C. Davison

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo NY* and that *John J. Davison* resides at the same place and that they own each seven sixteenths, and that *Henry J. Painter* resides in *New York City* and owns the remaining two sixteenths and that they all are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Schooner Elk Bates of Buffalo* whereof *John J. Davison*

is at present Master; and as he has sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Erie* State of *Pennsylvania* in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her *Temporary Enrollment at the Port of Chicago, dated April 4th 1864* and *numbered "77"* now surrendered having arrived at her home Port

And *Said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Schooner* or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *136* feet *11* inches her breadth *30* feet inches her depth *11* feet inches and that she measures *three hundred sixty five* tons *Twenty* ninety-fifths that she is a *Schooner* has *square* stern head and *square* head.

And the said *William C. Davison* and *John J. Davison* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
