In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that James Van Buren resides at the same place, and that they are

each one half part Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal Boat Edward Dixon of Buffalo whereof Charles Kimeharz is at present Master; and as he has sworn he is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1862 as appears by the certificate of Robert Mills, shipwright, her builder, on file in this Office, and dated May 10. 1864

And Sanford Hoalbert surveyor appointed to measure said Boat having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is 95 feet 9 inches her breadth 17 feet 9 inches her depth 18 feet 8 inches and that she measures One Hundred + thirty two tons forty seven ninety-fifths that she is a Canal Boat and has a stern head and no figure

And the said R. P. Noble agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
