In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam" passed 7th July, 1833, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th 1850,

Geo. S. Kingman

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Sloop Atlanta of Buffalo whereof he

is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1855, as appears by the Certificate of Charles G. Beck shipwright, her builder, on file in this Office, and dated May 12. 1864

And Ira Barnard Jr. surveyor appointed to measure said Sloop having certified that the said Sloop or vessel has one deck and one mast and that her length is 25 feet 6 inches her breadth 11 feet 10 inches her depth 2 feet 6 inches and that she measures Five tons 71 ninety-fifths that she is a Sloop has a square stern and no figure head.

And the said Geo. S. Kingman agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Sloop has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
