In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo N.Y. and that H. C. Winslow resides at New York City, and owns seven sixteenths (7/16), that H. J. Winslow resides at the same place and owns seven sixteenths (7/16) and that S. S. Ramage resides at Cleveland Ohio, and owns the remaining two sixteenths (2/16); and that they all are,*

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propeller Dean Richmond of Buffalo whereof S. S. Ramage is at present Master; and as he has sworn he is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1864, as appears by the Certificate of her former Enrollment at the Port of Cleveland, dated April 29, 1864, and numbered 33, now surrendered, having changed Owners and District

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has one deck and one mast and that her length is 258 ⁸⁰/₁₀₀ feet inches her breadth 34 ²⁵/₁₀₀ feet inches her depth 13 ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ feet inches and that she measures Ten Hundred & eighty three tons 44 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a round stern and plain head.

And the said *Henry C. Winslow* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
