And Linus E Harris, surveyor appointed to measure said Tug having certified that the said Tug Propeller or vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is 50 feet inches her breadth 11 feet 3 inches her depth 5 feet 4 inches and that she measures Twenty seven tons 30 ninety-fifths that she is a Tug Propeller has a round stern head and no figure

And the said John O'Brian agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Tug Propeller has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
