No 19. and in and by which said Certificate
the said Tug Propeller was enrolled, as
belonging one third part thereof to me said
William J. Bates, one third part thereof to
James Day of Rochester N.Y. and one third
part thereof to John Day of Rochester
N.Y. which Certificate has been lost
destroyed or mislaid, and that if the
same be found again, and within my
power shall be returned to the
Collector of the District of Buffalo Creek
where it was granted

this 18th day of June 1864
