In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1881, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1880, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N. Y. and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Ellington of Buffalo whereof L. W. Ingraham is at present Master; and as he has sworn he is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Vermillion State of Ohio in the year 1847 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Cleveland dated July 20, 1858, and numbered "60" now surrendered having changed Owners & District

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 101 feet 6 inches her breadth 22 1/2 feet 3 inches her depth 9 feet inches and that she measures One Hundred & eighty five tons 88 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern head. And the said John H. Montgomery and scrobb having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
