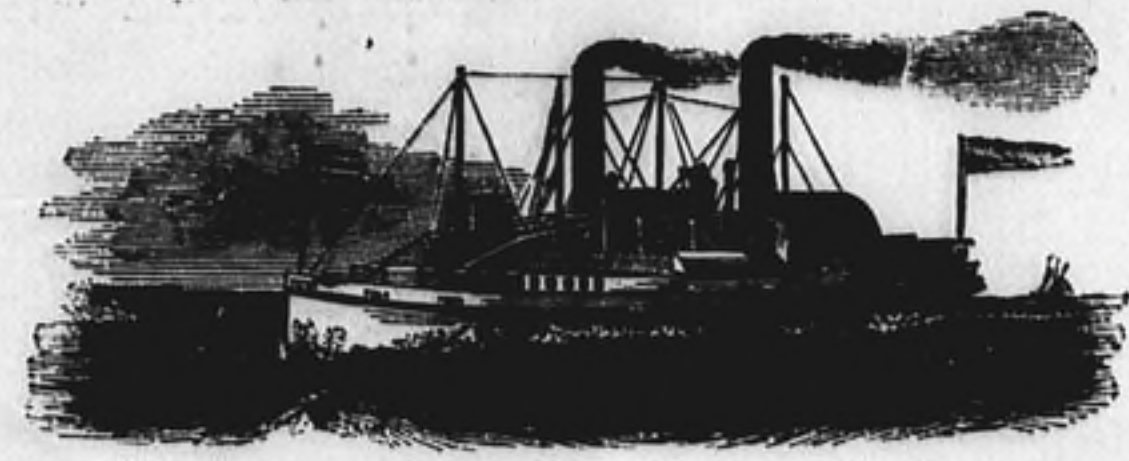

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Vermillion State of Ohio in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port dated July 29. 1864 and numbered 203, now surrendered having changed Owners

And said Enrollments having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that
her length is 101 feet 6 inches
her breadth 22 feet 3 inches
her depth 9 feet inches
and that she measures One Hundred and eighty five tons 83 ninety-fifth
that she is a Schooner has a square stern
and scroll head.

And the said John H. Montgomery
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
