In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1798; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Detroit Mich, and owns two thirds, and that Andrew Summerfield resides at the same place, and owns the remaining own third, and that they are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig C. B. Blair of Chicago
whereof Leander Simoneau

is at present Master; and as he has sworn her is a
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Michigan City
State of Indiana in the year 1848, as appears by the Certificate of her last
Enrollment at the Port of Chicago, dated April 15. 1864, and
numbered 102, now surrendered, having changed Owners & Districts

And said Enrollment having certified that
the said Brig or vessel has one deck and two masts and that
her length is 110 feet 6 inches
her breadth 24 feet 3 inches
her depth 8 feet 7 1/2 inches
and that she measures One Hundred Twelve tons 36 ninety-fifths
that she is a Brig has a no gallery stern
and scull head.

And the said Leander Simoneau having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of
the said acts, the said Brig has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
