In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same, also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo NY
and that Oliver J. Burt resides at the same place, and
that they both are

each one half part
Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Barque Samuel Ward of Buffalo
whereof Seth Clark

is at present Master; and as he has sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at New York
State of Michigan in the year 1847 as appears by the Certificate of her former
Enrollment at this Port, dated November 12. 1862 and numbered
179 now surrendered having changed Owners

And said Enrollment having certified that
the said Barque or vessel has one deck and three masts and that
her length is 178 feet 6 inches
her breadth 25 feet 6 inches
her depth 9 feet 8 inches
and that she measures Four Hundred Twenty three tons 37 ninety-fifths
that she is a Barque has a square stern
and no figure head.

And the said Seth Clark
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of
the said acts, the said Barque has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
