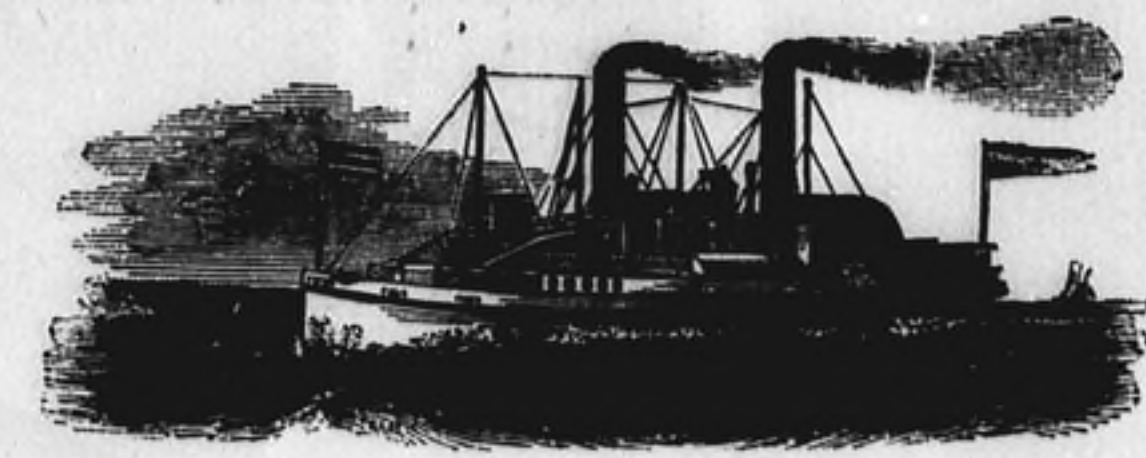

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

Seth Clark

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that he owns one half (1/2), that J. S. Noyes resides at the same place, and owns one quarter (1/4), and that Wm. G. Grant, now reside at New York City, and own the remaining one quarter (1/4) and that they all are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Barque Samuel Ward of Buffalo whereof Charles Graves is at present Master; and as he has sworn he is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at New York State of Michigan in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her former Enrollment, at this Port, dated August 17th 1864, and numbered 211, now surrendered, having changed Owners.

And the said Barque or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 178 feet 6 inches her breadth 25 feet 6 inches her depth 9 feet 8 inches and that she measures Four Hundred & twenty three tons — 37 — ninety-fifths that she is a Barque has a square stern head and no figure

And the said Seth Clark agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this 17. day of August in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four.
