In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1850, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

State of *New York* in the year *1864* as appears by *the Certificate of C. A. Van Slyke,*  
*Shipwrights, her builder, on file in this Office, and dated October*  
*1864*

And *Ira Barnard Jr.* Surveyor appointed to measure said *Tug Prop* having certified that  
the said *Tug Prop* or vessel has *one* deck and *no* mast and that  
her length is *60* feet *6* inches  
her breadth *15* feet *6* inches  
her depth *6* feet *9* inches  
and that she measures *Fifty five* tons *56* ninety-fifths  
that she is a *Tug Propeller* has a *round* stern  
and *no figure* head.

And the said *Nicholas Sutton* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Tug Prop.* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
