And Sanford Halbert surveyor appointed to measure said Tug having certified that the said Tug Prop or vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is 54 feet inches her breadth 14 feet 6 inches her depth 7 feet inches and that she measures Forty eight tons 41 ninety-fifths that she is a Tug Propeller's and has a Fan Sail stern head.

And the said A. L. Griffen and no figures having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Tug Prop has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
