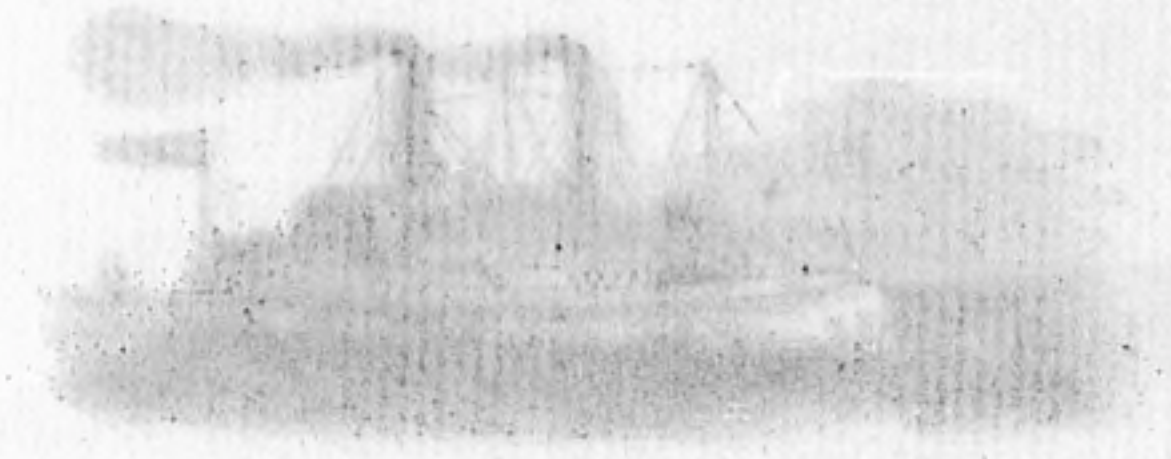

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that H. C. Winslow resides at New York City and owns two thirds (2/3), and that Daniel T. Clough resides at Whitford Vt and owns the remaining one third (1/3), and that they both are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *Yankee* of Buffalo whereof *Joseph Kimball* is at present Master; and as he has sworn

he is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at New York State of Michigan in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at the Port of Detroit, dated May 18. 1863 and numbered 93, now surrendered having changed Owners + District

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 139 feet inches her breadth 25 feet 9 inches her depth 12 feet 3 inches and that she measures Four Hundred and ten tons 22 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and no figure head.

And the said H. C. Winslow having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
