In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1833, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Ashtabula Ohio and that he owns one sixth (1/6), and that J W Haskel & son reside at the same place and own one sixth (1/6), and that Marshall Haskel resides at the same place and owns one sixth (1/6), and that J. S. Noyes resides at Buffalo N.Y. and owns one quarter (1/4), and that Wm. G. Grant & son reside at New York City, and own the remaining one quarter (1/4), and that they all are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Barque Samuel Ward of Buffalo whereof Crawford Large is at present Master; and as he has sworn

her Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at New Port State of Michigan in the year 1847 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated August 17, 1864, and numbered 212, now surrendered having changed Owners & Districts

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Barque or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 178 feet 6 inches her breadth 25 feet 6 inches her depth 9 feet 8 inches and that she measures Four Hundred & twenty three tons 37 ninety-fifths that she is a Barque has a square stern head and no figure

And the said Crawford Large having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
