In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Barnstable Mass. and owns one fourth (1/4), and that Owen Bearse & Co. reside at Boston Mass, and own one fourth (1/4), and that Joshua Baker and John W. Baker reside at the same place and own each one fourth part (1/4) and that they all are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Barque C. E. Rosebury of Buffalo whereof Owen Bearse is a

is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Conneaut State of Ohio in the year 1864, as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Register at the Port of Milwaukee, dated Oct. 28. 1864 Numbered 3, now surrendered having arrived at home port, and changed Owners.

And said Register having certified that the said Barque or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 140 ¹⁸/₁₀₀ feet inches her breadth 26 ²⁰/₁₀₀ feet inches her depth 12 ⁷/₁₀₀ feet inches and that she measures Four Hundred and thirty seven tons 60 ninety-fifths that she is a Barque has a square stern head and plain head.

And the said Owen Bearse having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
