In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1881, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1898, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Sandusky Ohio and owns one third $\frac{1}{3}$ and that Samuel H. Pratt, Pascal P. Pratt and Edward P. Beals reside at Buffalo N.Y. and that they under the firm Pratt & Co own two thirds $\frac{2}{3}$ and that they all are

Citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Brig Commerce of Sandusky whereof H. H. Merry is at present Master; and as he has sworn that he is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Sandusky State of Ohio in the year 1857, as appears by the Certificate of her former Enrollment at this Port dated Feb. 15. 1865 number (4) now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 138 feet inches her breadth 31 feet 1 inches her depth 10 feet 11 inches and that she measures three hundred & twenty six tons 35 ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has a square stern head and small head.

And the said Henry H. Merry agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
