In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo* State of *New York* in the year 1855, as appears by the Certificate of his former Enrollment at this Port dated *May 28* 1858 and numbered *68* now surrendered having changed owners

And said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *126* feet *—* inches her breadth *28* feet *6* inches her depth *—* feet *—* inches and that she measures *Three hundred and fifty* tons *35* ninety-fifths that she is a *Square* stern head.

And the said *Henry C. Winslow* and *Warren Eagle* having agreed to the description and measurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
