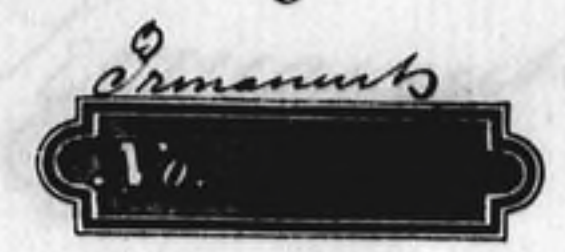

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850, and the act of the 6th of May 1864

Elijah B. Gibson

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N. Y. and that he owns one half (1/2) and that J. M. Sterling and J. W. Haldy reside at Monroe Michigan and own each one fourth (1/4), and that they all are

Citizens of the United States, and sole owners of the Schooner Rebecca of Buffalo whereof E. B. Gibson is at present Master, and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Toledo State of Ohio in the year 1853, as appears by

the Certificate of her former Enrollment at the Port of Erie dated May 20th 1864 now surrendered. Vessel having been remeasured under act of May 6th 1864

Sanford Haldy Surveyor having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 111 5/16 feet inches her breadth 23 3/4 feet inches her depth 10 feet inches and that she measures One hundred and eighty five tons 89/100 ninety fths that she is a Schooner has a round stern and no figure head.

And the said E. B. Gibson having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
