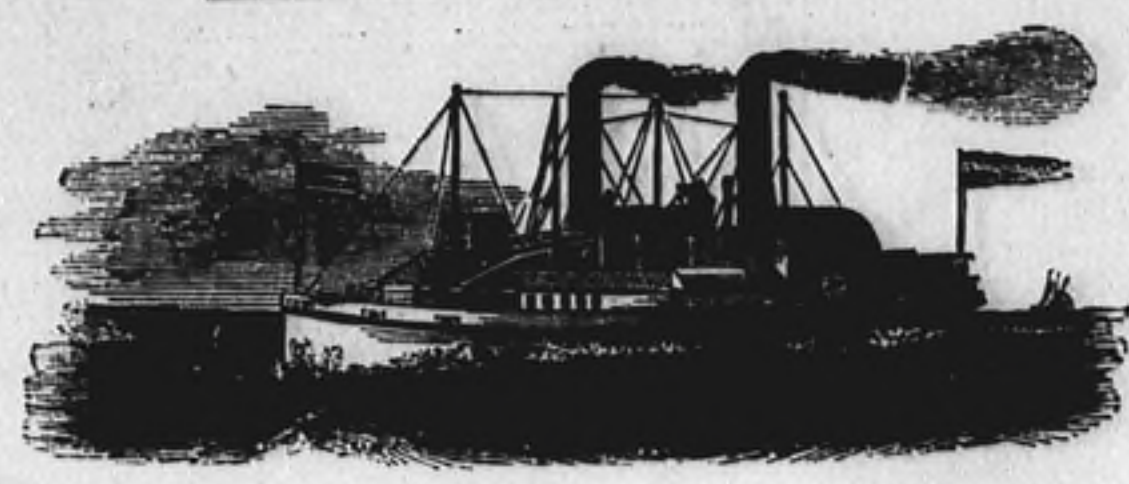

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850, and Act of May 6 1864

 Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Perryburgh*
 State of *Ohio* in the year 1845, as appears by *the Certificate of her former*
Enrollment at this Port, dated April 10. 1862 numbered 22,
now surrendered, Vessel having been readmeasured under Act
of May 6. 1864

And *Sanford Halbert* surveyor having certified that
 the said Schooner or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that
 her length is *97* feet *inches*
 her breadth *23 1/2* feet *inches*
 her depth *9 1/2* feet *inches*
 and that she measures *One Hundred & thirty seven* tons *1500* *ninety-sixths*
 that she is a *Schooner* has a *square* stern
 and *scroll* head.

And the said *Francis Boland* having
 agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of
 the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
