In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1881, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1888, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850,

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that she is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Barque Oneonta of Buffalo whereof Emery Closs

is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her former Enrollment at this Port dated April 18th 1862 numbered "28" now Surrendered Vessel having been readmeasured under Act of May 6th 1864

And A. D. Atkins having certified that

the said Barque or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 160 ¹³/₁₀₀ feet inches her breadth 31 ⁴⁰/₁₀₀ feet inches her depth 12 ²⁴/₁₀₀ feet inches

and that she measures Four Hundred tons 59/100 ninety-fifths that she is a Barque has a Square stern and a Scroll head.

And the said Charlotte A. Watson having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
