In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850, and Act of May 6. 1865.

Robert Burns

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Lake Port, Mich and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Lewis C. Butts of Buffalo whereof he is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Euclid State of Ohio in the year 1850, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated March 2<sup>d</sup> 1863 and numbered 12, now surrendered having changed Owners and Districts, and having been remeasured under Act of May 6. 1864

And Sanford Halbert Surveyor having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 89 7/10 feet inches her breadth 23 7/10 feet inches her depth 8 7/10 feet inches and that she measures One Hundred and nineteen 7/100 tons ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a stern and head.

And the said Robert Burns and Scroll having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
