In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850, and Act of May 6th 1864.

State of *Michigan* in the year 1860, as appears by *the Certificate of her former Enrollment at this Port, dated June 30th 1863.*
and numbered 136, now surrendered having changed Owners, and having been remeasured under Act of May 6th 1864.

And *J. Barnard Jr* Surveyor having certified that
the said *Schooner* or vessel has *one* deck and *three* masts and that
her length is *140 7/10* feet *—* inches
her breadth *26 5/100* feet *—* inches
her depth *12 4/10* feet *—* inches
and that she measures *Three Hundred and eleven* tons *63/100* net weight
that she is a *Schooner* has a *square* stern
and *no figure* head.
