In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850, and Act of May 6, 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that H. J. Winslow resides at New York City and owns three fourths <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> and that David Vance resides at Milwaukee, Wis. and owns <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, and that they all are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owners of the "Barque Imilight" of Buffalo whereof David Vance is at present Master; and as he has sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Cleveland State of Ohio in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Register at the Port of Chicago, dated April 14, 1864, and numbered "2", now surrendered, having changed Districts and having been remeasured under Act of May 6, 1864.

And Sanford Stalbert Surveyor having certified that the said Barque or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 136 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet inches her breadth 25 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet inches her depth 11 <sup>8</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet inches and that she measures Three Hundred and ninety tons that she is a Barque has a square stern and plain head.

And the said Henry C. Winslow having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Barque has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
