In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850, and Act of May 6. 1864

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and owns 1/2th of the said Schooner; that Thomas Coatsworth resides at the same place and owns 1/3rd that Charles Hamilton resides at New Haven N.Y. and owns the remaining 1/4th part and that they are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner H. B. Fairchild of Buffalo whereof Charles Hamilton is at present Master; and as he has sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Charlotte State of New York in the year 1857 as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated June 25. 1864. and numbered 186. now surrendered, having been remeasured under act of May 6 1864. and having changed owners

And Ira Barnard Jr Surveyor having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 135 1/2 feet inches her breadth 25 1/2 feet inches her depth 10 1/2 feet inches and that she measures Two Hundred and fifty one tons 24/100 ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a square stern and no figure head.

And the said Robert Mills having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
