And Sanford Halbert surveyor having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has one deck and one mast and that her length is 168 25/100 feet inches her breadth 27 4/10 feet inches her depth 11 4/10 feet inches and that she measures Six Hundred and sixty four tons 116/100 ninety-fifths that she is a Propeller has a round stern and a plain head.

And the said Thos D Dole having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propeller has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
