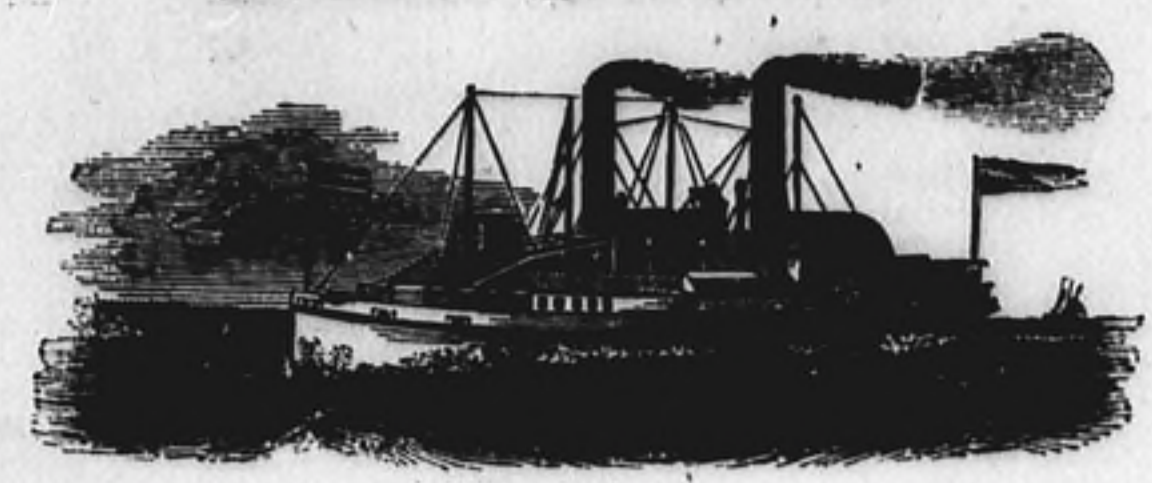

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850, and Act of May 6. 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo N.Y.* and owns two thirds (2/3) and that *Charles C. McDonald* resides at the same place and owns one third (1/3) and that they are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *Invincible* of Buffalo whereof *H. G. Morey* is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo* State of *New York* in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 18. 1864. and numbered 73. now surrendered, having been remeasured under Act of May 6. 1864

And *Sanford Halbert* surveyor having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and three masts and that her length is 137 1/10 feet inches her breadth 30 feet inches her depth 11 feet inches and that she measures *Three Hundred and seven* tons 2/100 ninety fifts that she is a Schooner has a square stern head.

And the said *John B. Griffin* and *no figure* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
