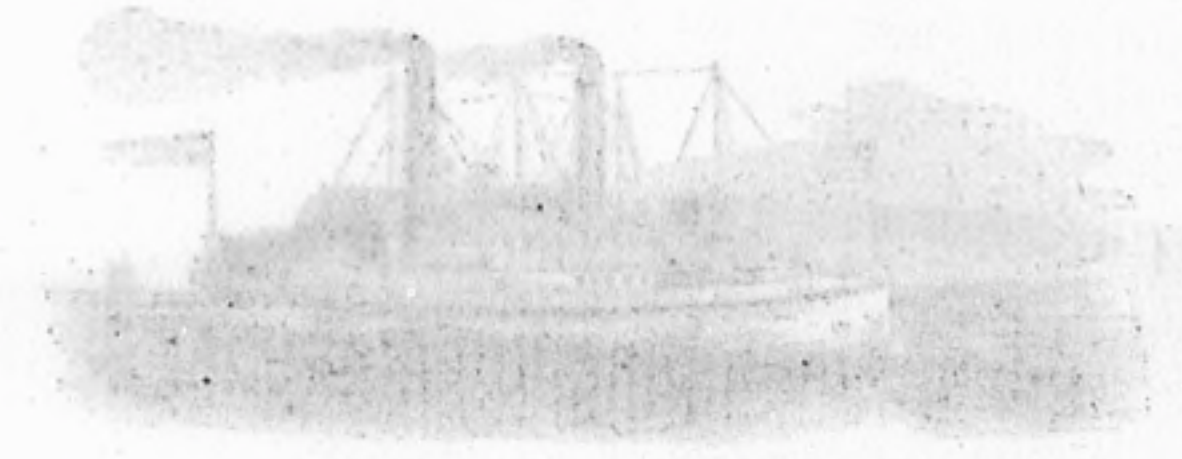

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850, and Act of May 6 1864

Henry Purdy  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Chicago Illinois  
and that owns one third (1/3) and that William MacCreedy  
resides at the same place and owns the remaining two thirds  
(2/3) and that both are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner Potomac of Buffalo  
whereof Henry Purdy  
is at present Master; and as he has sworn he is a  
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Oswego  
State of New York in the year 1853, as appears by the Certificate of her former  
Enrollment at this Port dated 27<sup>th</sup> February 1865 registered "1"  
now surrendered having changed ownership and Districts  
and having been re-enrolled under Act of May 6 1864

And John Bernard Jr Surveyor  
the said Schooner or vessel has on deck and three masts and that  
her length is 120 feet — inches  
her breadth 24 1/2 feet — inches  
her depth 9 9/16 feet — inches  
and that she measures Two hundred and Eight tons 55/100 ninety-fifths  
that she is a Schooner has a Square stern  
and a Scroll head.

And the said Henry Purdy  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of  
the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
