In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850, and Act of May 6. 1864.

James Prouty

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Brig Venice of Buffalo whereof Dwight D Prouty is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Rochester State of New York in the year 1847, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 21. 1860. and numbered 222 now surrendered having been remeasured under an act of May 6 1864.

And J. P. Barnard Jr Surveyor having certified that the said Brig or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 146 feet inches her breadth 25 1/2 feet inches her depth 9 1/2 feet inches and that she measures Two Hundred and seven tons 27,000 ninety fms that she is a Brig has a square stern and a keel head.

And the said James Prouty having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
