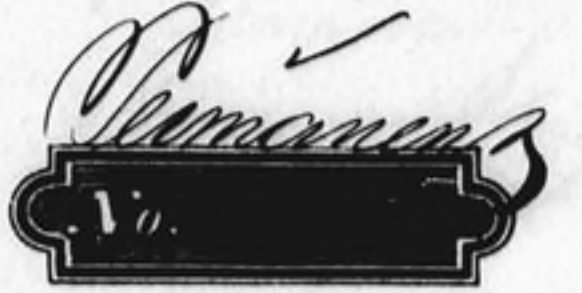

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850, and Act of May 6, 1864.

Thos D Dole

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at Buffalo N.Y. and that he is Secretary of the Buffalo and Detroit Transportation Company of Buffalo N.Y. and that the said Company is the true

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Propella Sugarman of Buffalo whereof John Hall

is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Ohio City State of Ohio in the year 1850, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port dated April 14, 1864, and numbered 57, now surrendered, having been remeasured under Act of May 6, 1864

And Sanford Halbert Surveyor having certified that the said Propella or vessel has two deck and one mast and that her length is 154.5 feet inches her breadth 27 feet inches her depth 9.4 feet inches and that she measures Five Hundred and fifty five tons 57 lbs ninety lbs that she is a Propella and has two Gallies stern head.

And the said Thos D Dole having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Propella has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo, in the said District, this 29 day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five.
