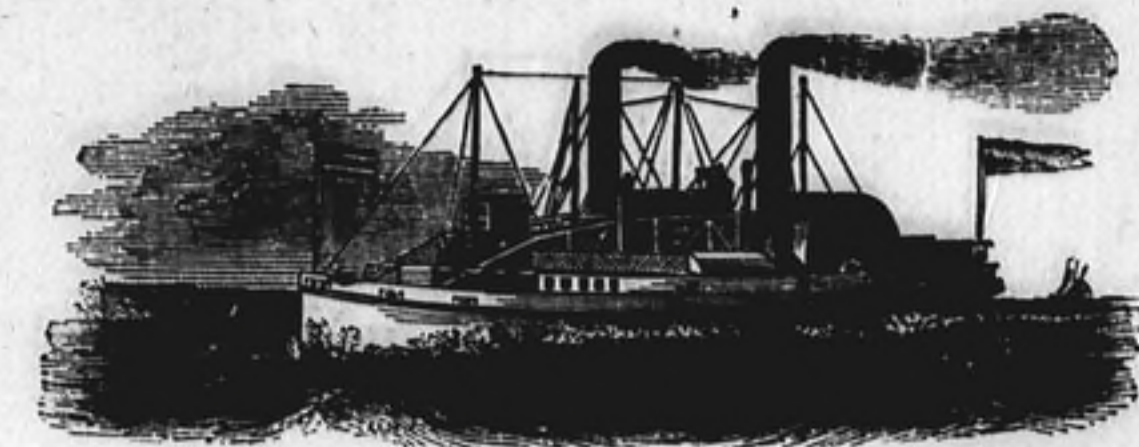

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850, and Act of May 6-1864.

is at present Master; and as he has sworn Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Erie State of Pennsylvania in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated April 15, 1864, and numbered 56, now surrendered having been remeasured, and Owners changed

And Sanford Halbert Surveyor having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 90 feet inches her breadth 23 feet inches her depth 9 feet inches and that she measures One Hundred and twenty $\frac{1}{100}$ tons ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a stern and head.

And the said Michael Mangin having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
