And Ira Barnard Jr Surveyor having certified that the said Propeller or vessel has two decks and one mast and that her length is 169 ⁵/₁₀₀ feet inches her breadth 27 feet inches her depth 11 ⁴/₁₀ feet inches and that she measures Six Hundred and twenty two tons ⁴²/₁₀₀ ninety-nine that she is a Propeller has a square stern and no figure head.
