In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850, and Act of May 6. 1864.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo N.Y.* and that *Abel T Blackmar* resides at the same place and that they are

each one half Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *Ellen M. Baxter* of *Buffalo* whereof *Thomas Baxter* is at present Master; and as he has sworn

that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Wellington Square* State of *Canada West* in the year 1861, as appears by the Oath of *Thomas Baxter* her Builder on file in this office and bearing even date herewith Enrolled under Act of Congress approved February 25. 1865. and by letter of the Secretary of the Treasury dated February 25. 1865

And *Wm Gardner* surveyor having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *one* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *121 1/2* feet *—* inches her breadth *25 1/2* feet *—* inches her depth *9 1/2* feet *—* inches and that she measures *Two Hundred and four* tons *6 1/2* ninety fives that she is a Schooner and *square* stern head.

And the said *Thomas Baxter* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
