Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Tropeller Queen of the Lakes of Buffalo whereof Lewis Cray is at present Master; and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River Ohio in the year 1852, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port, dated August 24. 1864 and numbered '220' now surrendered having been remeasured

And J. L. Blanchette surveyor having certified that the said Tropeller or vessel has two decks and one mast and that her length is 184 5/100 feet inches her breadth 26 7/100 feet inches her depth 10 42/100 feet inches and that she measures Six Hundred and thirty seven tons 84/100 ninety-fifths that she is a Tropeller has a round stern and plain head.

And the said Edwin J. Evans having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Tropeller has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
