In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c." passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, North-eastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850, and Act of May 6, 1864

Pascal P. Pratt

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo N.Y.* and that he is a

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Schooner *Wm Varnatta* of Buffalo whereof *Thomas White*

is at present Master; and as he has sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Erie* State of *Pennsylvania* in the year 1862, as appears by the Certificate of her Temporary Enrollment at the Port of Erie dated April 22nd 1865, and numbered "14" now surrendered, having arrived at home Port

And *R. F. Gaygin* having certified that the said Schooner of vessel has *One* deck and *two* masts and that her length is *118 ¹⁰/₁₀₀* feet — inches her breadth *24 ¹⁰/₁₀₀* feet — inches her depth *8 ¹⁰/₁₀₀* feet — inches and that she measures *One Hundred and fifty nine* tons *87/100* *ninety-five* that she is a Schooner has *no* square stern head.

And the said *Pascal P. Pratt* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
