And said enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is 135 65 feet — inches her breadth 25 85 feet — inches her depth 10 20 feet — inches and that she measures 264 400 tons ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has a Square stern and plain head.

And the said J. W. C. Davison agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
