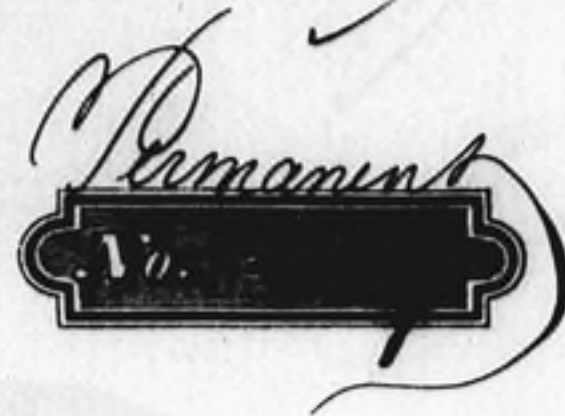

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the Canal Boat Massachusetts of Buffalo whereof P. A. Root is at present Master, and as he has sworn

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1854, as appears by the Certificate of M. H. Willig shipwright her builder on file in this Office and dated May 13, 1865.

And Sanford Halbert Surveyor having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is 95 feet inches her breadth 17 4/10 feet inches her depth 4 4/10 feet inches and that she measures One Hundred and one tons 23/100 ninety-fifths that she is a Canal Boat has a round stern and no figure head.

And the said Pird A Root having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
