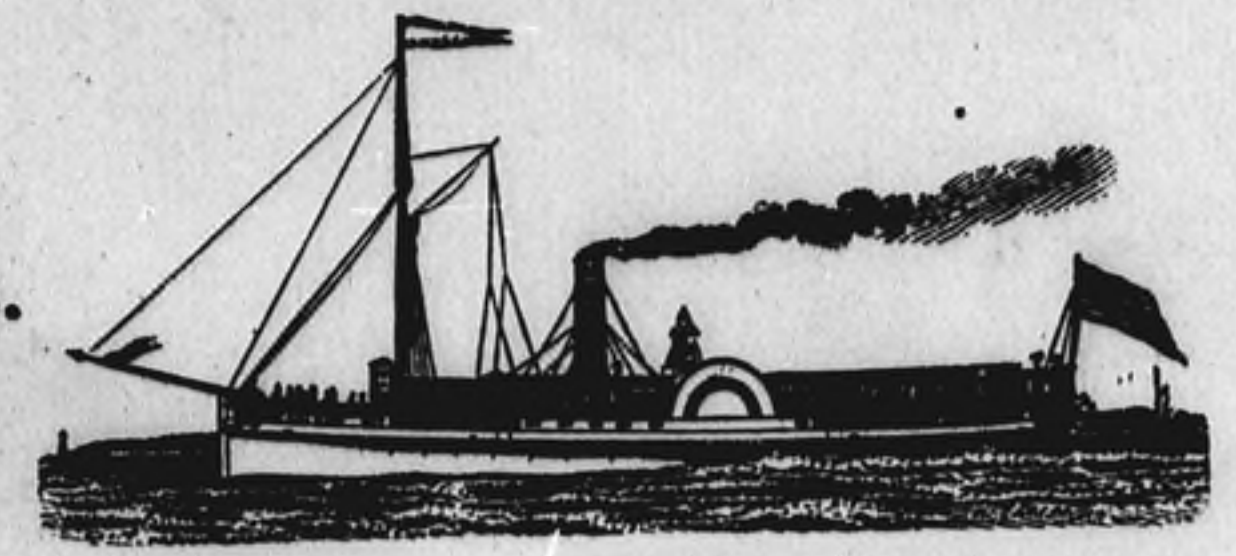

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 30th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850. and Act of May 6, 1864

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo State of New York in the year 1864 as appears by the Certificate of G. B. Notter shipwright, her builder, on file in this Office, dated May 12, 1865

And Sanford Halbert surveyor having certified that the said Canal Boat or vessel has one deck and no mast and that her length is 94 7/10 feet inches her breadth 17 7/10 feet inches her depth 8 7/10 feet inches and that she measures One Hundred and twelve tons ninety-fifths that she is a Canal Boat has a round stern and no figure head.

And the said D. Gazlary having agreed to the description and advertisement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Canal Boat has been duly enrolled at the PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.
