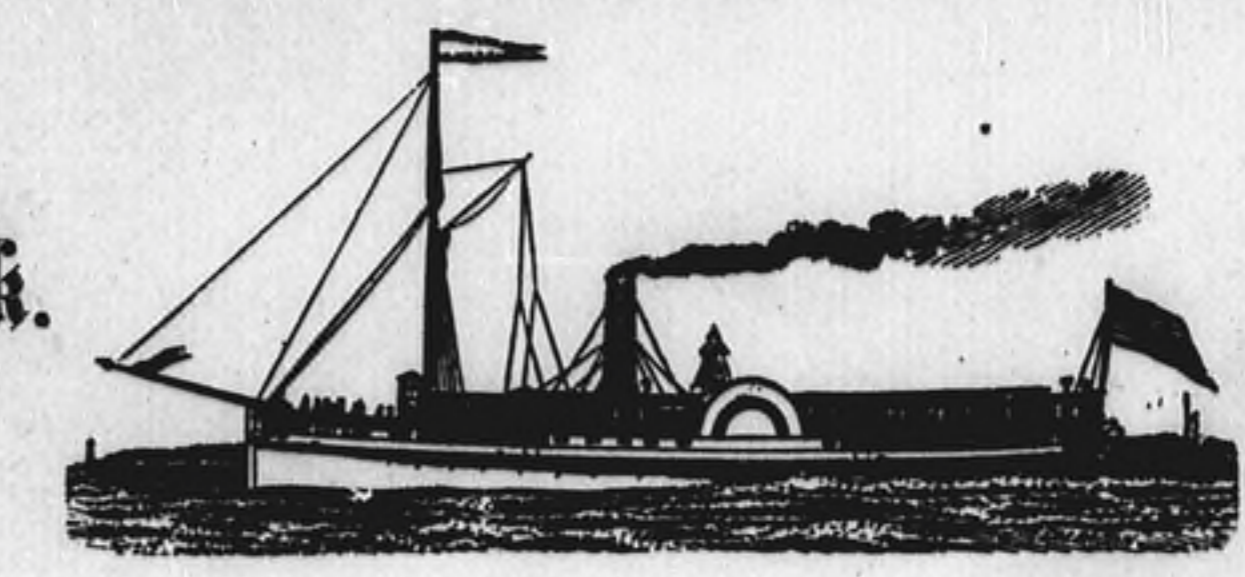

In Conformity to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels, &c.," passed 18th February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed March 2d, 1831, and "An Act to Provide for the better security of the Lives of Passengers on board Vessels propelled in whole or in part by Steam," passed 7th July, 1838, and the Act of August 20th, 1852, amending the same; also an Act entitled "An Act to provide for Recording the Conveyances of Vessels, and for other purposes," passed July 29th, 1850. *and Act of May 6, 1864.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he resides at *Buffalo N.Y.* and that *John H Roberts* resides at *Whitesboro N.Y.* and that they both are

Citizen of the United States, and sole owner of the *Canal Boat S. A. Gillespie* of *Buffalo* whereof *John H Roberts* is at present Master, and as he has sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Havana* State of *New York* in the year *1863*, as appears by the Certificate of her last Enrollment at this Port dated *May 21, 1864* and numbered *160* now surrendered, having been unmeasured and *renamed*

And *John Parnard Jr. Surveyor* having certified that the said *Canal Boat* or vessel has *one* deck and *no* mast and that her length is *90 1/10* feet *inches* her breadth *17 1/2* feet *inches* her depth *8 1/2* feet *inches* and that she measures *One Hundred and eighteen* tons *1/10* *Sixty-fifth* that she is a *Canal Boat* has a *round* stern and *no figure* head.

And the said *John Stevenson* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Canal Boat* has been duly enrolled at the **PORT OF BUFFALO, N. Y.**
